Training	Eligible	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Research training & networking activities for trainees • Student exchanges and internships
	Ineligible	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Development & delivery of for-credit academic courses
Consumables & Supplies	Eligible	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Materials and supplies to support community building and professional development activities
	Ineligible	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consumables and supplies for research activities
Equipment	Ineligible	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Equipment for research
Travel	Eligible	U of T travel policies must be followed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student exchanges¹ • Invited speakers • Visiting scholars

General & Administrative	Eligible	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Costs related to meetings and events (A/V, space booking fees). • Communication materials (reports, websites, policy briefs) • Office supplies • Hospitality (alcohol is not eligible)
